Sub: Load flow study of substations proposed under DDUGJY scheme

Sir,


Under DDUGJY scheme, New and Augmented Substations have been sanctioned in your State/DISCOM. As per requirements (refer chapter-II, clause 1(i) of DDUGJY guidelines), States were required to submit load flow studies justifying creation of New & Augmentation of 33/11 KV (or 66/11 KV) substations. However, load flow studies for these system strengthening works were not submitted at the time of submission of original DPRs or revised DPRs.

The issue was discussed during DDUGJY scheme review meeting by Ministry of Power on 29.08.2016. It was desired that Load-flow studies for creation of each new/augmented substation in the DISCOM/State must be submitted indicating existing substations / lines in the vicinity of proposed new/augmented substation, before taking up the works at sites.

You are, therefore, requested to kindly provide load flow studies report in 03 (three) weeks' time for each new/augmented proposed substations under DDUGJY scheme.
