Subject: **Electrification of balance UE villages in Betul, Annupur, Mandla, Narsingpur & Umaria Districts of MP State under DDUGJY- Issue of forest clearance- Approval by the State.**

Sir,

Greetings to you. Your kind attention is invited to the letter cited under reference above on the captioned subject (Copy enclosed). Out of the DDUGJY sanction for electrification of UE Villages in the state of MP, 18 UE Villages in Betul, Annupur, Mandla, Narsingpur & Umaria Districts of Madhya Pradesh are in the forest area. To electrify these villages, forest clearances are needed as intimated by MPPoKVVCL & MPMKVVCL. The details are enclosed at **Annexure.**

It was intimated by DISCOMs that the state forest approval has already been obtained and the Central/MoEF forest approval is pending. On perusal of the matter by the Chief Project Manager, REC, Bhopal Project Office with Shri Bhaskar, Deputy Conservator of Forest, Bhopal, it was informed that the proposal is likely to be approved shortly in next Regional Empowered Committee meeting of MoEF.

In this connection, we have had a meeting with Shri Soumitra Das Gupta, Inspector General of Forest (IGF) (Wildlife), Ministry of Environment, Forest & Ecology, at New Delhi on 28.03.2017 to discuss the issue regarding the forest clearances pertaining to the above 18 UE Villages. The IGF has intimated that wherever the central forest and environmental clearance (wildlife) is required, the proposal seeking the forest & environment clearance (wildlife) from the Chief Wildlife Warden, MP / Chief Conservator of Forests, MP after getting the approval of the state Govt. shall have to be sent to the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Paryavaran Bhavan, Jor Bagh Road, New Delhi-110003. After receipt of the above proposal from the state, it shall be put-up for the approval by the National Board for Wildlife (NBWL). The IG has also mentioned that the State Govt. has also been vested with powers to accord approval for issuance of forest clearance in some cases.

In view of the above, it is requested to arrange to get the approval of the competent authority to obtain the needed forest clearance for the above mentioned UE Villages. If the state Govt. has already sent the proposal seeking the approval of the Ministry of

Environment, Forest & Ecology (Wildlife), New Delhi, a copy of the same may please be arranged to be send to this office on top priority for further follow up with the Ministry. It is requested to arrange to send the status of obtaining the forest clearance to this office.

Your valuable support in the matter to declare all the UE villages in the state as per the timeline set by the Ministry of Power is highly solicited please.

This may be treated as most urgent please.

Subject : **Electrification of balance UE villages in Narsinghpur District of MP State under DDUGJY Programme- Issue of forest clearance from MoEF**

Sir,

Greetings to you. As you are aware that Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana (DDUGJY), a flagship scheme of the Govt. of India is being implemented on 'Mission mode' for electrification of rural villages across the country. Hon'ble Prime Minister at his 69th Independence Day speech has announced that all the Un-electrified villages (UEV) across country will be electrified in 1,000 days. PMO is reviewing progress of village electrification work on 'PRAGATI' portal. Rural Electrification Corporation Ltd. (REC), the nodal agency of the above program is monitoring the implementation of the scheme and it is also being monitored by the Ministry of Power on 'GARV' App. All out efforts are being taken to complete electrification of all UEVs by April 2017.

Ministry of Power has sanctioned financial assistance under DDUGJY for electrification of UE Villages across the state of Madhya Pradesh and strengthening the power distribution infrastructure. Out of the above sanction, 8 UE Villages in Narsinghpur district are in the forest area. To electrify these villages, forest clearance from state forest department is urgently needed as reported by the DISCOM.


