Subject: Pre-dispatch Inspection of materials under DDUGJY.

Sir/Madam,

You are kindly aware that 3-tier Quality Assurance Mechanism viz. TPIA (tier-I), RQM (tier-II) & NQM (tier-III) is envisaged to ensure quality of works under DDUGJY (RE) XI & XII plan DDUGJY schemes. For DDUGJY new projects, MoP has approved single tier Quality Assurance Mechanism. For this, REC shall outsource independent agency(ies) designated as REC Quality Monitors (RQM) to ensure quality of materials and quality of works. Detailed scope of RQM works are mentioned in enclosed guidelines.

In this connection, we request you to ensure following points:

- 1) Approved Manufacturing Quality Plan (MQP), approved Technical Specification, approved GTPs, approved Drawings and approved Data Sheets are to be sent along with the inspection calls in order to avoid delay in deputing inspectors by REC. It is retreated to mention that Technical Specifications finalised by Committee-A are to be used without any variations for all type & sizes of Power Transformer(s), Distribution Transformer(s), Conductors and Cables. No deviations are allowed in this respect.
- 2) 100% material inspection requisitions for all the items covered under RQM scope are to be forwarded to REC. REC at its own discretion will send RQM agency for witnessing the inspection at the premises of the manufacturer as per DDUGJY Quality Assurance Mechanism guidelines.
- 3) Materials inspection call requisitions are to be raised in prescribed format (copy enclosed) indicating district/project-wise quantities of materials to be inspected, giving 5-6 working days' time for deploying RQM inspectors.
- 4) Inspection is to be carried out on the scheduled date & time as finalized by PIA. No variation in quantity, date & venue shall be allowed. If the material is not ready on the scheduled date of inspection, then the inspection call shall be treated as fake call & penalty of ₹50,000/- shall be imposed on the contractor towards deployment of inspector.

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

It is also clarified that inspection is to be performed on the scheduled date of inspection in the presence of atleast one inspector (PIA inspector or RQM inspector). If PIA inspector doesn't participate but RQM participate in the inspection, REC shall issue recommendation for issuance of Dispatch Instruction based on the report submitted by RQM. Also, in case RQM inspector doesn't participate in the inspection on scheduled date & venue, then the PIA inspector shall perform the inspection & DI to be issued by PIA accordingly. In both the cases, work shall not hamper for want of RQM or PIA inspector.
