**Minutes of the 4th meeting of DDUGJY Monitoring Committee held  
on 06.08.2015 at 11.00AM in Conference Room,  
Shram Shakti Bhawan, Rafi Marg, New Delhi**

The 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of DDUGJY Monitoring Committee was held under the chairmanship of Secretary (Power) on 06.08.2015. The list of participants is enclosed at **Annexure-I**. Detailed agenda was issued by Ministry of Power on 05.08.2015.

At the outset, CMD, REC (Member Secretary & Convener) welcomed all the members and briefed Secretary (Power) and Addl. Secretary (Power) about the agenda for the meeting. Executive Director (DDUGJY), REC made a presentation on item-wise agenda for consideration by the Monitoring Committee.

**Agenda Item No. 1: Confirmation of minutes of the 3rd meeting of the Monitoring Committee**

The Minutes of the 3rd meeting of the Monitoring Committee held on 17th July 2015 were circulated to all concerned on 27<sup>th</sup> July 2015. No comments from any quarter have been received. Hence, the Minutes of the meeting were confirmed.

**Agenda Item No. 2: Action taken report on decisions of last Monitoring Committee meeting**

**Agenda Item No. 3: Sanction of new projects under DDUGJY**

ED (DDUGJY), REC informed that the Budget allocation for 2015-16 is Rs. 4500 Cr. of which Rs. 1500 Cr would be required for ongoing RE projects (Erstwhile RGGVY) and balance available for the new projects is Rs. 3000 Cr. The estimated capital subsidy requirement for FY 2015-16 for the DDUGJY projects (including the proposed projects) can be met out from the allocated budget.

He also briefed about salient features of the new projects as under:
